3. Ensure that the child packs the school bag with books required for the day.

5. It is obligatory for everyone entering the school to follow COVID-19 guidelines, like wearing a mask, maintaining social distancing, washing / sanitizing hands frequently and informing the school, in case, anyone in the family has tested positive for COVID-19 or is showing symptoms like fever, cough or breathlessness.
6. The school buses are plying on regular routes and students can avail the bus facility.
7. Following the social distancing norms, classes will be split into two. The class teacher will share the room number in the class whatsapp group. Once in school, the child is expected to move directly to his/her class room after sanitizing hands at the school gate.
