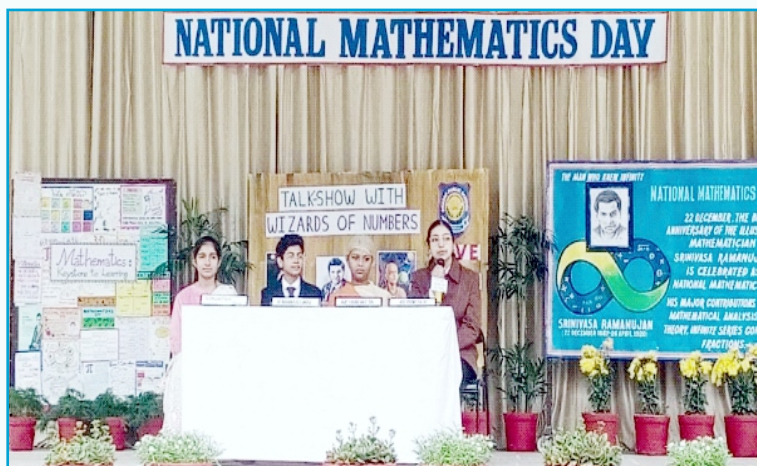
TRIBUTE PAID TO THE STALWARTS OF INDIA'S FREEDOM STRUGGLE

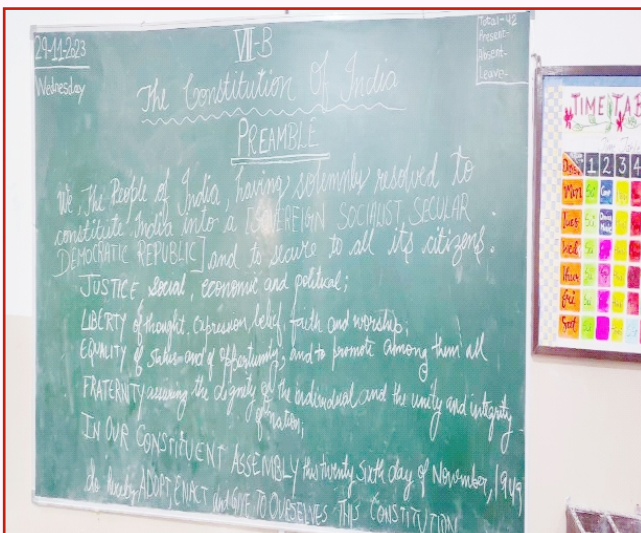
INTERNATIONAL KIDS FILM FESTIVAL: AN INCREDIBLE CINEMATIC JOURNEY

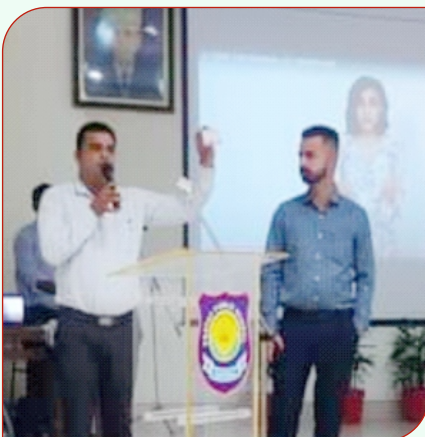
The inter-active training session impressed upon the fact that gender equality not only promotes confidence and empathy among students, but it also provides more opportunities.

INVESTITURE CEREMONY



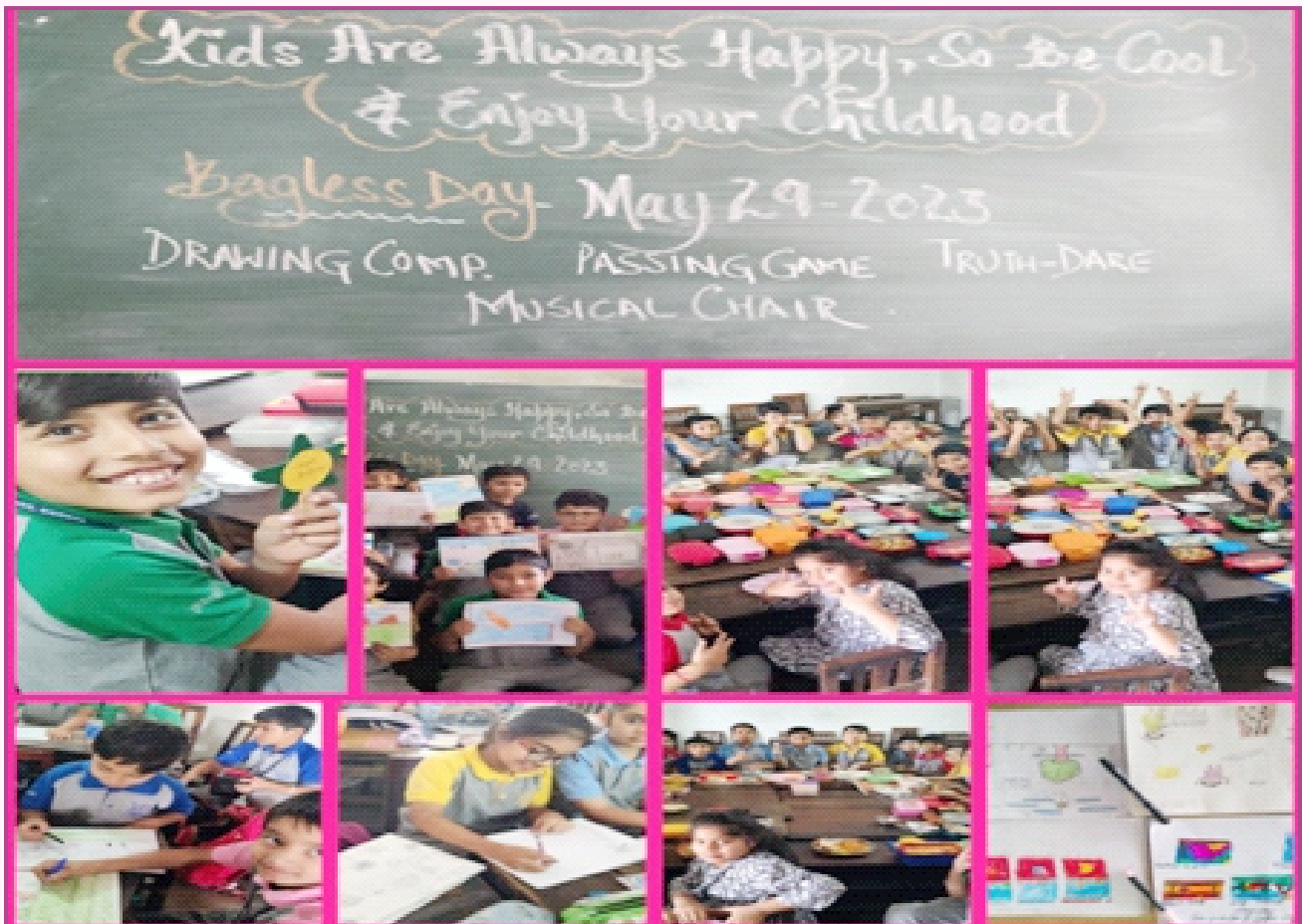

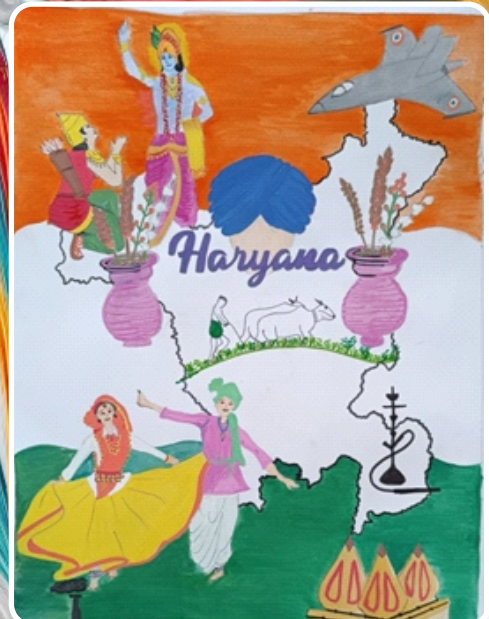
