- 5. Encourage your child to pack only the necessary books and notebooks for the day to keep their school bag light.

- 7. Kindly avoid picking your child during school hours unless there is a major, unforeseen eventuality.
- 8. Don't send your children for private tuitions, it unnecessarily makes them dependent on others.
- 9. To familiarize yourself with the school rules and regulations, it is important to review the School Almanac along with your child.
