The school flag continued to flutter high even in the session 2024-25. The young Pratapians continued their winning streak in grade X and XII Board Exams.

Academics:

This year's spectacular results in the XII Boards were highlighted by our young prodigy –Arushi Bansal from Jarnailly Colony School who topped the district in the Commerce stream with 98.6% marks. Nikunj and Sparsh followed closely with 97.2% marks each, while Jannat secured third position with 97%. The brilliant performance of the Senior Secondary Level was perfectly replicated by the students at the Secondary level. Paras Saroha topped the school by scoring 97.4%, while the second position was won by Divija and the third by Chetanye Vashist with 97% and 96% respectively.

Another remarkable feature of this year's result is the rich haul of cent percenters. Many students scored 100 out of 100 in various subjects. One of the school toppers, Sparsh Garg achieved the rare distinction of scoring cent per cent in both Economics and Accountancy. Aakansha Singh and Pavithra made us proud by scoring a remarkable 100 in Pol. In grade X, 14 of our students secured 100 per cent marks in AI, Aayan Mehla made us proud by scoring 100 marks in General Science and Social Science, whereas Mitul, Sanyam, Divija, Tanushi, Tanisha and Keshav got 100 in Mathematics. Our school Topper Ishika Mehla secured 100 in Social Science.

The highlight of the session was the stellar performance of our students in the JEE Mains. 14 of our prodigies studied for and excelled in the JEE Mains and brought fame to the school. They were prepared for the competition by our In-house Faculty.

Sports

Our prodigious sports persons brought accolades by proving their mettle not only at the state but also at the National Level Games.
